Organise a Bake Off





- Organise at your place of work, school or at a regularly attended event.
- Give people plenty of time to get some ideas brewing, buy ingredients, and make their bakes.
- Price each piece of cake or slice at a reasonable price and create small pieces allowing everyone to try a bit of each.
- Choose a judge to decide who's won your 'bake off'.
 Do you have a natural Mary Berry or perhaps a Paul Hollywood in the office?

- Some good categories for judging are taste, presentation, inventiveness and originality
- Maybe ask one of our speakers to come down and judge on the day, accompany it with a talk letting everyone know what a great cause they are raising money for.
- You could also get everyone to write down their favorite and secretly submit them – the people's choice award!
- You can issue a certificate (which we can provide) for the winner.
- It is always a good idea to get your bakers to write down all the ingredients of their bakes before putting them on sale. Just to ensure any one with allergies is well informed.
